
Road Construction in Ethiopia

The Project for Rehabilitation of Trunk Road

- · Rehabilitation of trunk road from the capital. Addis Ababa, to Debre Markos
- The first phase of construction started in 1999, and currently, the fourth (last) phase is under construction (Total length 294km)
- · Construction at elevations of 3,000m 1,000m above sea level
- · Black cotton soil (BCS), that shrinks during the dry season and swells in the wet season, is widely distributed as alluvial soil in East Africa.
- · Japanese government grant aid projects

Phase 1

Export from Japan by charter ship, and then 1,000km of Inland transportation from the Port of Djibouti in the neighboring country to the project site (2,500m above sea level) in the

landlocked nation of Ethiopia



Phase 2

Ensuring water for construction by digging additional wells (More than 3,000m above sea level)



Phase 3

Hedase Bridge opening ceremony 303m-long extradosed bridge built over the Blue Nile River (2,500m - 1,000m - 2,500m above sea level)



Phase 4

Flood area Replacement of BCS with impermeable liners as a countermeasure (2,500m above sea level)
